- b. Received FEMA approval for \$ 11,000 to replace tile on 4th Street that was washed out.
- c. On behalf of the city, the Corps of Engineers received federal funding for \$ 150,000 to conduct a feasibility study including a hydrology component for a potential flood control/entertainment pond/lake to be located on the 78-acre tract of land donated to the city a few years ago.
- d. We received required documentation for the water line interconnect to the City of Greenup Water system known as the 207 Interconnect project. We hope to have the project started this summer.

- e. Documentation is completed and a checking account has been made for the Rock Gate water line project including pump replacement on State Route 1458. This project will be started this summer and will take a year or longer. This is a 100% funded AMLER grant we received in 2024 with an estimated \$ 1.8 to \$ 2 million dollars that will provide city water to an estimated 30 homes that currently do not have a clean water source.
- f. Update on the approved funding from the 2026 KY Legislature for (LARP) Local Assistance Road Program grant to mill and pave Turley Ave., Central Ave., First St., and partial Diedrich Drive in the 2027 budget for a total amount of \$ 183,000. The funding will be released later this summer.
